This is our second Annual Report after the Germany couple Alexandra Gunther and Michael Gunther founders of the organization were resigned but they continue to fund-raise, motivate and advise us I am still grateful for their help from there until now. This Annual Report is presenting all the work we were doing from January 2018-December 2018.

New News about Ikhaya loxolo in 2018

Mr Mancie from special program unit at Mbashe local municipality took two garden

members for farming training at Tsolo agricultural centre.

In this year we have a new partnership with the accredited organization called Kwenzekile Community Development Centre, it helps people in computer skill, workers of iKhaya loxolo and youth from our communities get computer skill from them, in this year 60 people were Graduated, and graduation ceremony was also attended by the Honourable Mayor Mr Janda. We want to improve a high rate of education in our rural communities.

In April we were doing ABCD workshop so that people learn to wake up and do something by their own, and use their assets they have, like natural assets to get what they do not have. Ikhala Trust is the organization from Port Elizabeth that was Facilitating the workshop.

Ikhala Trust took three members from the organization on the $7^{\rm th}$ of November to the God's way farming workshop at Port Elizabeth, and on the $26^{\rm th}$ of November Ikhala Trust came to our centre for some general issues and other organizational staff

Facilitators and their students from University of Stellenbosch were here at our centre for two days on September, and they gave us some garden tools and they promised to come back, however they came on the first week of December for disability workshop, which was so incredible as we learned many things about disability-like different types of disability models.

We got the Hammer mill for income generation by grinding the maize and sell millie meal.

In after school program we add the other school called Ganizulu S.S.S now we have three schools instead of two.

Farming Program and Live stock



iKhaya loxolo have two farms for income generation by producing organic vegetables and we also feed our disabled people healthy food, we sell it at Madwaleni doctors twice a month, sell at haven Hotel, sell to the local, Join agricultural competitions.

We want to plant more in 2019 so that we can sell even to the markets. We also have Livestock 7 goats, 3 cows, 17 pigs, 4 sheep's and we generate income by selling piglet.

After school Program



This is an educational outreach for learners from the very remote area.

In this year we assist 3 different schools 60 learners at **Nkintshana S.P.S**, we visit there one hour, two days per week before the learners go back to their homes, we help them in the reading, home works, assignments and calculations

30 learners from **Hobeni J.S.S** come to our centre 1 hour in the afternoon from Monday to Friday and we help them in their home works and assignments and also in their difficult subjects and we do career guidance to empower them while they are still young.

Ganizulu S.S.S we go there two days per week and help grade 10 learners by Languages, Mathematics and Accounting so that they can get good results at the end.

Our aim is to assist our brothers and sisters to have an access in Tertiary institutions and further their studies so that they have a better future, we want to show them the importance of education in people's life.

Structure of Ikhaya loxolo in 2018

Our structure have the changes of the members that were gone suddenly, others they got other jobs.

Whereas the other members they are interested to came and volunteer in our organization.

But the rest of the workers are still involve at Ikhaya loxolo they say raining or not, no matter we are in a darkness or brightness we want to develop our communities we want to make changes in our communities.
